New students must provide test scores to Dixie State College when or before applying for admission and registration. Returning students have met this requirement, unless students have new test scores. High school students must register for at least 3 credits; however, some students may register for more. Please check with your high school counselor before submitting your application. In order to receive state funding, students are only allowed to enroll in 30 credits per year, which is generally 15 credits per semester.****
