PROGRAM GUIDELINES: To be considered for a WUE waiver, applicant must be legal resident of a participating state. The states are: Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota, Washington, or Wyoming.

- Applicant must be fully admitted to Dixie State College, prior to submitting application.
- Entering freshman must have a minimum 2.8 high school GPA to apply. Priority given to highest GPA's.
- Transfer student must have a minimum of 24 transfer credits and a 2.8 cumulative transfer GPA.
- Applicant must be degree seeking and enrolled in an eligible program at DSC*(see attached list).
- Applicant must be a full-time student (12 credit hours per semester).
- Applicant must meet satisfactory academic progress requirements each semester to maintain eligibility.
- WUE waivers are non-deferrable. Student must re-apply for WUE program upon returning to DSC.

By signing this application I certify that the information provided here is true. I understand that tuition for WUE students is 150 percent of the institution's in-state tuition, and that it is my responsibility to pay the balance of tuition, fees and any other applicable charges by the posted deadlines. I further understand that WUE waivers may not be used in conjunction with other non-resident tuition reduction waivers (including athletic waivers). As part of the WUE program regulations, I may not claim time on this waiver towards applying for Utah residency.

Q. Why are some programs ineligible for the WUE waiver?

A. For a number of reasons i.e. some programs are non-traditional and don't meet semester requirements or the credit hour requirements. Cohort and accelerated bachelor programs have different tuition calculations, based on program length and not residency status. High demand degrees have waiting lists and do not accept tuition reduction programs.

Q. Is there an application deadline?

A. Priority Deadline for WUE Applications is March 1st. However, the number of WUE awards is limited. Awards are offered until all slots are filled. Late applicants are put on a waiting list and contacted (in order of eligibility & date of application) as slots become available.

Q. I am an Athlete, how does WUE work if I receive athletic waivers?

A. DSC policy does not allow for the stacking of waivers in excess of full tuition and most athletic waivers don't coordinate well with WUE waivers. Due to this problem, we no longer offer WUE to athletes and request that you not apply. If you have questions, please contact the scholarship office.

Q. Why can't I apply for residency after a year on WUE?

A. WUE is an exchange program coordinated by Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education (WICHE). The purpose of the WUE program is to increase the geographical diversity of students in Utah Colleges. Students applying for WUE should be seeking a certificate/degree at DSC but not looking to gain resident status as that is not the intent of the program.
