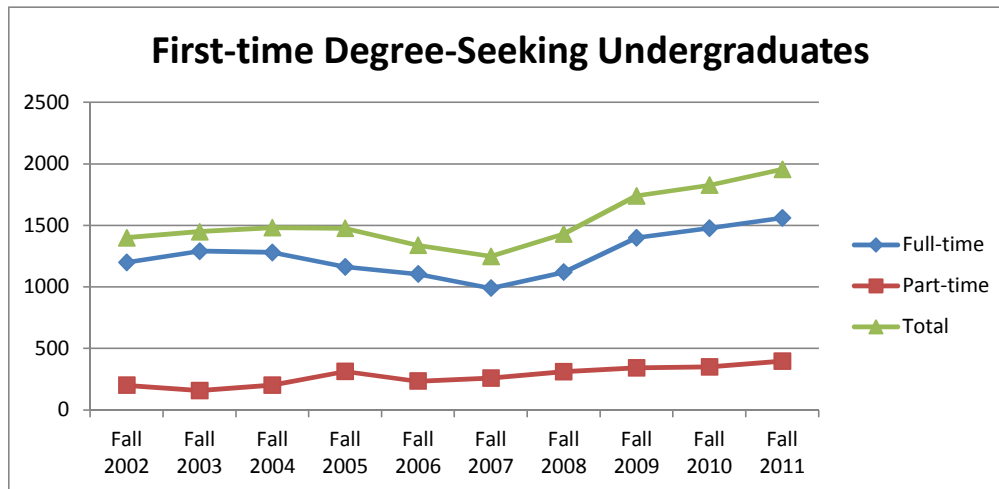

First-time student (undergraduate)

A student who has no prior postsecondary experience (except as noted below) attending any institution for the first time at the undergraduate level. This includes students enrolled in academic or occupational programs. It also includes students enrolled in the fall term who attended college for the first time in the prior summer term, students who entered with advanced standing (college credits earned before graduation from high school), and those that received an Associates Degree at High School Graduation.

** In 1990 anyone admitted was categorized as first-time freshman
