Student Right-to-Know Report on Graduation/Transfer Rates for Potential Student-Athletes (Sect. 668.48)

Under the Student Assistance General Provisions, Student Right-to-Know Act, Sect 668.48, each institution participating in any title IV, HEA program, when it offers a potential student-athlete athletically-related student aid shall provide to the:

- \* Potential student-athlete,
- \* His or her parents or guardian,
- \* High school coach, and
- \* Guidance counselor,

the following information on completion and graduation rates, transfer-out rates and other data produced in accordance with Sec. 668.48. The institution shall also submit to the Secretary of Education, the report produced by July 1, 1997 and each July 1 every year thereafter.

In accordance with Sec. 668.48, each institution attended by students receiving athletically related student aid shall produce:

- I. Number of students, categorized by race and gender, who attended that institution during the year prior to submission of report
- II. The number of students described in paragraph I. who received athletically related student aid, categorized by race and gender within each sport
- III. The completion or graduation rate and transfer-out rate of all fall term entering, degree/certificate seeking, full-time undergraduates, categorized by race and gender
- IV. The completion or graduation rate and transfer-out rate of cohorts described in paragraph III. who received athletically related student aid, categorized by race and gender within each sport.
- V. The average completion or graduation rate and transfer-out rate for the four most recent completing or graduating classes of entering students.
- VI. The average completion or graduation rate and transfer-out rate for the four most recent completing or graduating classes of entering students who received athletically-related aid.

The following pages detail our current rates as defined above.

Privacy Issues with Disclosure

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974, as amended 1998, (FERPA) requires that institutions not disclose information where students could be identified.

The disclosure guidelines cited in 34 CFR Section 668.48 (a)(3) of the Student Assistance General Provisions say that if a category within an athletic subcohort contains five or fewer students, the institution need not disclose information on that category of students. NCES will not release data cells containing fewer than three individuals.
