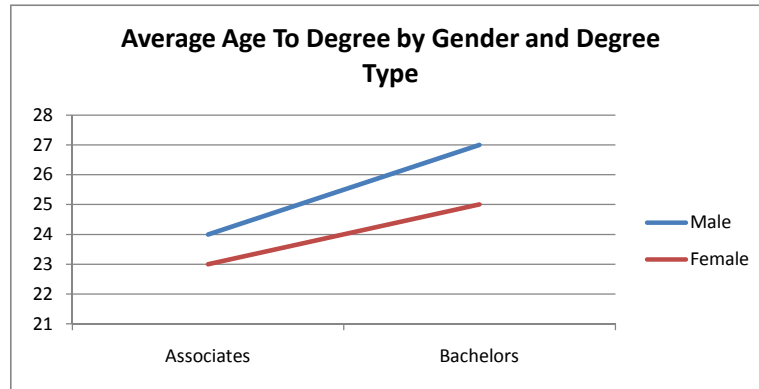

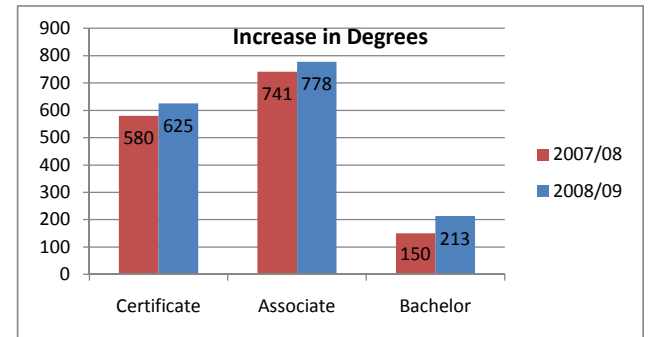

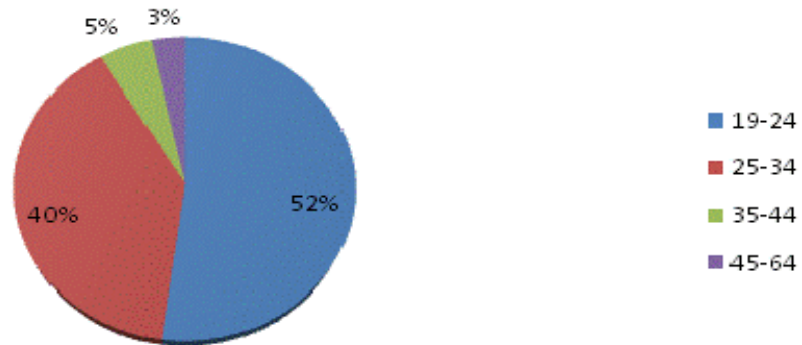

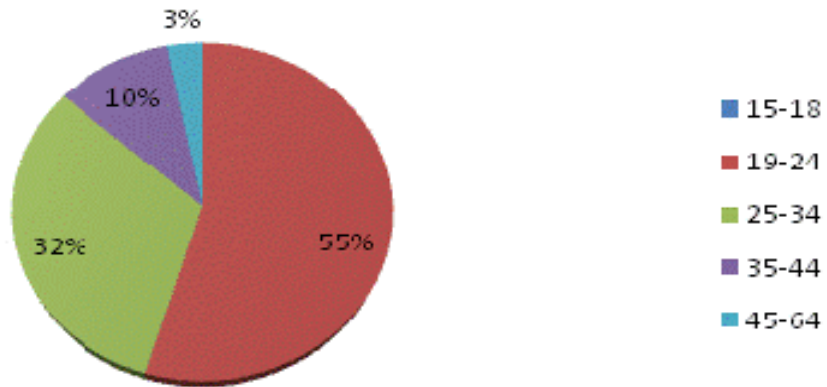


## Ages Groups of Graduates 2008/09
